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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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RESOLVE, Authorizing the Treasurer of State to Receive  
One, One Thousand Dollar United States Second Liberty  
Loan, Four Per Cent. Bond, in Full Release and Discharge  
of a Legacy of One Thousand Dollars, Bequeathed to the  
Central Maine Sanatorium by the Will of the Late John  
Prescott.

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Resolved: That the treasurer of state be and hereby is  
2 authorized to receive from the executors of the will of  
3 the late John Prescott, one, one thousand dollar United  
4 States, second Liberty Loan, four per cent. bond, in full  
5 release and discharge of a legacy of one thousand dollars  
6 bequeathed to the Central Maine Sanatorium by the will of

7 the late John Prescott, to be held by said treasurer of state  
8 for the use and benefit of said Central Maine Sanitorium  
9 as specified in said bequest. The said treasurer of state  
10 is hereby authorized and empowered upon receipt of said  
11 bond to deliver to said executors proper receipts and ac-  
12 quittances therefor.
