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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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RESOLVE, Providing for a Seal of the State.

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Resolved: That the secretary of state be directed to procure a seal of the state, conforming to the sketch and device adopted by resolve of the legislature, June nine, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and that he cause the device to be engraven thereon, and that said seal, when completed, be deposited in the office of the secretary of state, and the same shall become and be the seal of the state.

Resolved: That the secretary of state be authorized to procure, for the use of the state, a press to accompany the seal.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars  
2 be and hereby is appropriated, for the purpose of defray-  
3 ing the expenses of procuring the seal and press aforesaid.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The seal of the state, in addition to being of a very crude design, is now badly worn. It has never conformed to the original resolve, adopted in 1820. (See chapter 4, Resolves of 1820.)
