STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Treasurer of State to Receive
the Sum of Five Hundred Dollars Bequeathed to the Central
Maine Sanitorium by the Will of the Late Valora Chase.

Resolved: That the treasurer of state be and hereby is
2 authorized to receive from the executors of the will of
3 the late Valora Chase, the sum of five hundred dollars be-
4 queathed to the Central Maine Sanitorium by said will,
5 to be held by said treasurer of state for the use and benefit
6 of said Central Maine Sanitorium as specified in said be-
7 quest, and the said treasurer of state upon receipt of said
8 sum is hereby authorized and empowered to execute and
9 deliver proper receipts and acquittances therefor.
