STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Kennebago Stream.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. No person shall fish for, take, catch, or kill 2 any kind of fish, at any time, in Kennebago stream, the 3 outlet of Kennebago lake, which stream is located in the

4 county of Franklin and in the county of Oxford.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in pos-2 session, at any time, any kind of fish taken in said Kenne-3 bago stream.

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be 2 subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than 3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense and one dollar

- 4 additional for each fish taken, caught, killed, or had in 5 possession in violation of this section.
- Sect. 2. So much of the rules and regulations of the De-2 partment of Inland Fisheries and Game promulgated on 3 June first, A. D., nineteen hundred and seventeen, as is 4 inconsistent with the provisions of this act is hereby re-5 pealed.
