STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Purpose of Obtaining Information in Regard to Wild Lands for the Purposes of Taxation.

Resolved: That the sum of five thousand dollars be 2 and hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred 3 nineteen, and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred 4 twenty, to be expended by the board of state assessors, 5 under the direction of the governor and council, for the 6 purpose of employing a competent person or persons whose 7 duty it shall be to assist said board in verifying and pro-8 tecting, so far as practicable, a proper description of each 9 parcel or tract of wild land, and the individual or corpor-

10 ate ownership thereof, in townships not incorporated, in 11 order that such lands may be properly described for taxa12 tion purposes, and for incorporating such description in 13 deeds when the lands are sold for taxes; also for the em14 ployment of a competent person or persons to assist said 15 board of state assessors in making such special explora16 tion of wild land townships, and such lands located in in17 corporated towns and plantations, as the board of state 18 assessors may deem advisable, to ascertain for taxation 19 purposes their just and fair value. Said board in its regu20 lar report shall incorporate a report of the work done under 21 this resolve and a summarized statement of their expendi22 ture.
