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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Deputy Treasurer of  
State.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen, of chapter one hundred seventeen, re-  
vised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred ninety-  
six, of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen,  
is hereby amended by striking out the word "eighteen," in the  
fifth and sixth lines of said section, inserting in place thereof  
the word 'twenty-three,' so that as amended said section  
shall read as follows:

'Sect. 16. The State treasury. R. S. c. 116, sect. 1.  
1915, c. 260, sect. 7. The treasurer of state shall receive an

3 annual salary of two thousand five hundred dollars; he shall  
4 receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.

The chief clerk in the office of the treasurer of state shall  
2 be designated as "Deputy Treasurer of State" and shall re-  
3 ceive an annual salary of twenty-three hundred dollars.'
