STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT relating to exemption from Poll Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All soldiers and sailors who served in the army or navy
2 of the United States in the war against Germany and
3 Austria shall be exempted from the payment of poll taxes
4 for the years nineteen hundred seventeen, nineteen hundred
5 eighteen and nineteen hundred nineteen.
