AN ACT Relative to the Appointment of Deputy Sheriffs and  
Their Compensation.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The sheriffs of the several counties may appoint  
2 such number of deputy sheriffs as may be necessary to per-  
3 form the duties required by section forty-nine of chapter one  
4 hundred twenty-seven of the revised statutes. Such deputies  
5 shall receive from the county treasury such compensation as  
6 the sheriffs shall fix, not exceeding four dollars per day.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are  
2 hereby repealed.
