STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, to Amend Chapter Eighteen, Resolve Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Animal Husbandry.

Resolved: Amend chapter eighteen, resolve nineteen 2 hundred and seventeen, by striking out the word "five" in 3 the third line and inserting the word 'six', so that said 4 resolve shall read as follows:

'Appropriation to be expended for improvement of animal 2 industry.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, 2 to be expended under the direction of the commissioner 3 of agriculture, the sum of six thousand dollars annually 4 hereafter for the purpose of improving and protecting the

5 animal industry of the state of Maine, by employing an 6 animal husbandry expert, and suitable assistance, and pay-7 ing such expenses in connection therewith as the commis-8 sioner may approve.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On recommendation of the governor and council, a sheep specialist was employed in 1918, a part of the year. To continue the work, the sum of \$6000 will be required each year.
