STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Thirty-four of the Private and
Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen Relating to
the Eastport Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter thirty-four of the private and special
2 laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen is hereby amended
3 by adding thereto the following sections to be known as
4 sections three and four of said chapter. Section three shall
5 read as follows:

‘The county commissioners of Washington county are
2 hereby authorized to reimburse Elisha W. Pike for the
3 cost of all Eastport municipal court blanks which they

4 may determine he had on hand, unused and in his posses-
5 sion, on the third day of July, A. D. nineteen hundred and
6 fifteen, and also to reimburse him for such additional
7 blanks as were purchased by him since said date for the
8 use of said court. Hereafter the said commissioners shall
9 provide all necessary blanks and dockets for the use of
10 said court.'

Sect. 2. Section four of said chapter shall read as fol-
2 lows:

'Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of judge
2 of said court by reason of death, resignation, removal or
3 expiration of term, the recorder of said court, while he
4 performs the duties of judge, shall have and receive the
5 salary provided for the judge of said court. This section
6 shall apply to all vacancies after December thirty-first,
7 nineteen hundred and eighteen.'
