STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Ice for Domestic Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Every person, firm or corporation engaged

- 2 in harvesting or selling ice for domestic use, shall obtain
- 3 a license therefor, to be issued by the commissioner of ag-
- 4 riculture. The fee for said license shall be five dollars.
- 5 Whenever required to do so by the said commissioner, any
- 6 person, firm or corporation harvesting or selling ice for
- 7 domestic purposes, shall furnish said commissioner with
- 8 samples of ice for purpose of having the same analyzed.
- Sect. 2. Every person, hrm or corporation engaged in 2 harvesting or selling ice as herein described shall annual-

- 3 ly file with the commissioner of agriculture, a financial 4 statement, the same to be in such form as the said com-5 missioner shall require.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates the provision of the act shall 2 be punished by a fine not less than twenty-five dollars and 3 not exceeding five hundred dollars.
