STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Ninety-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Small Loan Agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter two hundred and ninety-eight

- 2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is
- 3 hereby amended by striking out in the fifth line, after the
- 4 word "necessary," the word "traveling"; also by adding
- 5 after the second word "traveling," in the fifth line thereof,
- 6 the words 'and other'; also by adding after the word "the,"
- 7 in the sixth line of said section, the words 'appropriation
- 8 for that purpose and the'; also by striking out in the sev-

9 enth and eighth lines of said section the words "and the 10 balance of the fees shall be paid into the treasury of state"; 11 so that as amended said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 17. Examiner to be appointed to enforce law; com2 pensation. For the enforcement of the provisions of this
3 act the bank commissioner is authorized to appoint an ex4 aminer, the amount of his compensation to be subject to
5 the approval of the governor and council, who shall also
6 receive his necessary expenses. The salary and traveling
7 and other expenses, before mentioned, shall be paid out of
8 the appropriation for that purpose and the fees received
9 from licenses issued under the provisions of this act.'
