STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Esther M. Giles.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of eighty-four dollars and eighty-eight cents (\$84.88)
3 to be paid to Esther M. Giles, of Boothbay, as state aid,
4 she being a dependent in accordance with chapter two hun-
5 dred seventy-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred
6 seventeen. The above state aid being for the period from
7 the induction into the service of her husband and the date
8 of the filing of her application in writing with the select-
9 men of Boothbay.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Isaac M. Giles, husband of Esther M. Giles, was inducted into the service October 3, 1917. Mrs. Giles applied orally for aid in accordance with chapter 276 of the public laws of 1917, but failed to make application in writing until March 1st, 1918, from which date she has received state aid. Her husband, Isaac M. Giles, was killed in action in France October 3rd, 1918. There is due her from the state aid from October 3rd, 1917, until March 1st, 1918, the amount being \$84.88 which she needs to support herself and child.
