AN ACT Additional to Chapter Eight of the Revised Statutes
Relating to the Burning of Brush.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any person, firm, corporation or agent who cuts any wood
2 or lumber or clears any land within the woodlands of this
3 state and desires to dispose of the slash and debris caused
4 by such cutting or clearing by burning shall be first required
5 to obtain a permit therefor in accordance with the pro-
6 visions of section fifty-three of chapter eight of the revised
7 statutes, and on failure thereof shall be subject to the pen-
8 alty provided in said section.
