## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter Fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-five, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Three of the Private and Special Laws of One Thousand Nine Hundred and Three, Relative to Water Supply of Boothbay Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section two of chapter fifty-six of the private and spe2 cial laws of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five
3 as amended by chapter two hundred and three of the pri4 vate and special laws of one thousand nine hundred and

5 three is hereby amended by inserting in the sixth line after 6 the word "Boothbay" the word 'and,' and by inserting in 7 the seventh line after the word "and" and before the word 8 "Southport" the words 'to the island of,' and by striking 9 out in the seventh line after the word "to" the words 10 Squirrel Island," and by striking out in the eighth line after 11 the word "and" the words "other adjacent islands" and 12 inserting in place thereof the words 'Capitol Island,' and 13 by striking out in the eleventh line after the word "the" 14 the word "adjacent" and inserting in place thereof the 15 word 'said,' and by adding to said section the following: 16 'and to Squirrel Island Village Corporation at Spruce Point 17 in Boothbay Harbor,' so that said section, as amended, shall 18 read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said town is further authorized and empowered, 2 in case it obtains control of said corporation either directly 3 by purchase, or indirectly through ownership of stock, to 4 take water from Adams Pond in the town of Boothbay, 5 sufficient for all domestic, sanitary, municipal and com-6 mercial purposes, and to take and convey the same, through 7 the towns of Boothbay and Boothbay Harbor, and to the 8 island of Southport, and to Mouse Island and Capitol Island. 9 Said town is also authorized and empowered to sell water 10 to the towns of Boothbay and Southport, and to any com-11 pany, individual, firm or corporation in either of said towns, 12 or either of the said islands, and to Squirrel Island Village 13 Corporation at Spruce Point in Boothbay Harbor.'
