STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Payment of Additional Sums for Co-operative Agriculture.

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States adjourned on March third without making an appropriation for co-operative agriculture for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, under the proposed amendment to the Lever Act; and,

WHEREAS, said amendment will probably be passed at a special session of Congress before the convening of the next Legislature of this state; and,

WHEREAS, said appropriation, if authorized by Congress, carries twenty-nine thousand and nine hundred eighty-six dollars and fifty-eight cents for nineteen hundred and twen-

ty, and there has been appropriated for said co-operative work for the year nineteen hundred and twenty the sum of twentytwo thousand six hundred and seventy-two dollars and seventyeight cents; therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The governor and council are hereby authorized in the 2 event that the congress of the United States appropriates 3 for the year nineteen hundred and twenty the sum of twenty-4 nine thousand nine hundred eighty-six dollars and fifty-5 eight cents in favor of co-operative agriculture in this state, 6 to apportion from the state contingent fund the sum of seven 7 thousand three hundred thirteen dollars and eighty cents, 8 and to pay said sum or any other amount necessary to meet 9 the requirements of the act of congress, from said state 10 contingent fund.
