STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Acceptance by the State of Gifts of Land and for the Establishment of a State Park and Forest within the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The state land agent and forest commissioner
2 may, with the advice and consent of the governor and coun3 cil, accept on the part of the state gifts of land for forest
4 and park purposes. The title to lands acquired under this
5 section shall be investigated and approved by the attorney
6 general of the state.

Sect. 2. The purpose of this acquisition of land is hereby

2 declared to be the preservation of scenic beauty, facility 3 for recreation as nearly unrestricted and general as is prac-4 ticable by the people of this state and those whom they 5 admit to the privilege, and the production of timber for 6 watershed protection and as a crop. The lands acquired 7 within the limits described in section one shall never be 8 sold. They shall be protected from fire and damage from o other sources in an efficient and economical way. They 10 may be improved by roads and trails and also reforested 11 under direction of the land agent and forest commissioner 12 according to his best knowledge and judgment when funds 13 are available for that purpose. Timber may be sold and 14 camp sites leased by the state land agent and forest com-15 missioner with the approval of the governor and council 16 when in accordance with the purposes of this act as pre-17 viously stated; no contract of either character to be for 18 a term of more than five years. Revenues derived from 19 these uses shall be paid to the state treasury by the said 20 land agent and forest commissioner and constitute a fund 21 to be applied to the care and improvement of these lands 22 or to the acquisition of other lands for similar purposes.
