### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Ninety-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to Small Loan Agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter two hundred ninety-eight of

- 2 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "mentioned" in the
- 4 sixth line of said section, the words 'and all expenses of
- 5 administration and enforcement of this chapter' and by
- 6 inserting after the word "the" in the same line, the words
- 7 'appropriation for that purpose and the' and by striking
- 8 out at the end of said section the following: "and the bal-

9 ance of the fees shall be paid in to the treasurer of state,"
10 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 17. For the enforcement of the provisions of this 2 act the bank commissioner is authorized to appoint an ex-3 aminer, the amount of his compensation to be subject to 4 the approval of the governor and council, who shall also 5 receive his necessary traveling expenses. The salary and 6 traveling expenses, before mentioned, and all expenses of 7 administration and enforcement of this chapter shall be paid 8 out of the appropriation for that purpose and the fees region of the provisions of this 10 act.'
