STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Four of Chapter Four Hundred
Forty-six of the Private and Special Laws of 1897, Fixing
Compensation of Trustees of the Maine School for the Deaf.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter four hundred and forty-six of
2 the private and special laws of 1897 is hereby amended
3 by striking out the word "two" in the eleventh line of said
4 section and inserting in place thereof the word "five," so
5 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. The trustees shall have charge of the general
2 interests of the school and see that its affairs are conducted
3 in accordance with law and such by-laws as they may

4 adopt; they may adopt by-laws which shall be valid when
5 sanctioned by the governor and council; they may employ
6 a principal and such teachers and other employes as they
7 may deem advisable, and fix the compensation of the same
8 subject to the approval of the governor and council; they
9 may from time to time prescribe the system of education
10 and course of study to be pursued in the school and shall
11 be allowed for their services their actual expenses and five
12 dollars a day when actually employed.'
