AN ACT to Require a Fee for Registration of Milk Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Each milk dealer when applying for registration as provided for by section 5, chapter 37, R. S., and amendments thereto, shall pay to the commissioner of agriculture a fee of \$1.00 for each milk depot, vehicle and place from which sales are made. All money received by the commissioner of agriculture under this section shall be paid by him to the treasurer of the state, and the same is hereby appro-

8 priated for the purposes specified in chapter 37, and sec-
9 tions 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of chapter 130 of revised
10 statutes.
