### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Require a Fee for Registration of Milk Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Each milk dealer when applying for registration as pro-

- 2 vided for by section 5, chapter 37, R. S., and amendments
- 3 thereto, shall pay to the commissioner of agriculture a fee
- 4 of \$1.00 for each milk depot, vehicle and place from which
- 5 sales are made. All money received by the commissioner
- 6 of agriculture under this section shall be paid by him to
- 7 the treasurer of the state, and the same is hereby appro-

8 priated for the purposes specified in chapter 37, and sec-9 tions 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of chapter 130 of revised 10 statutes.
