STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relative to Unclaimed Shares of Estates in Any
Savings Bank or Like Institution, Deposited by Direction
of the Probate Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Any sums of money directed by a decree of
2 the probate court to be paid over which remained unclaimed
3 for six months in the hands of any executor, administrator,
4 guardian or trustee, and were deposited in some savings
5 bank or like institution as directed by the probate court to
6 accumulate for the benefit of the person entitled thereto
7 under section twenty of chapter sixty-seven of the revised
8 statutes of nineteen hundred and three, may, with all ac-
9 cumulations, be deposited in the treasury of the county in

10 which said probate court has jurisdiction for the benefit of
11 persons entitled, by decree of the probate court having orig-
12 inal jurisdiction of the proceedings, in which said decree
13 ordering such deposits was originally based.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein shall affect, modify or repeal any
2 of the provisions of section twenty-one of chapter seventy
3 of the revised statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen.
