HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE DOCUMENT 475,

Entitled AN ACT for the Care and Preservation of Shade
and Ornamental Trees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three is hereby amended by striking out the words
2 "and of all shrubs and other growths" in the seventh line,
3 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. The municipal officers of cities and towns not
2 having elected park commissioners as provided by sections
3 eighty-four to ninety-three inclusive of chapter four of the
4 revised statutes may at any annual meeting or meetings
5 called for that purpose appoint one or more tree wardens,
6 who shall have the care and control of all public shade
7 trees upon and along such highways and in the parks there-

8 of and all streets within any village limits and shall enforce
9 all laws relative to the preservation of the same.'
