AN ACT to repeal chapter seventy-five of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, "An Act to prohibit fishing for herring in Sheepscot and its Tributaries, by use of Seines or nets within two thousand feet of any trap or weir."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

4 use of seines or nets within two thousand feet of any trap
5 or weir," is hereby repealed.
