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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Prohibit the Manufacture and Sale of Cigarettes.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever by himself, clerk, agent or servant manufactures  
2 or causes to be manufactured any cigarette, or sells, offers  
3 for sale, has in his possession with intent to sell, or gives  
4 away to, or in any way obtains for any person any cigarette,  
5 cigarette paper, or any tobacco especially used for the roll-  
6 ing or making of cigarettes, shall be punished by a fine not  
7 exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment not ex-  
8 ceeding sixty days.

Trial justices and municipal court judges shall have juris-  
2 diction of offences under this section.
