STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Authorizing the Penobscot Development Company to Construct and Maintain Booms and Piers in the Aroostook River in the Town of Ashland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The Penobscot Development Company, a cor-2 poration organized under the laws of Maine, its successors
3 and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to erect
4 and maintain piers and booms in the Aroostook river in
5 the town of Ashland, between the highway bridge so-called
6 and piers of the Ashland Manufacturing Company just

7 above the mouth of the Big Machias, for the purpose of 8 holding all logs and lumber coming down said river for 9 their use.

Sect. 2. All piers and booms authorized by this act shall 2 be so constructed and maintained as not to impede navi-3 gation or to unreasonably hinder or delay the driving of 4 logs and lumber at all times.

Sect. 3. All logs and lumber belonging to other parties 2 and found in said boom shall be forthwith removed by 3 parties owning same at their own expense upon being re-4 quested in writing so to do.
