STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-seven, Revised Statutes, by repealing section 16.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Amend chapter 37, R. S., by repealing section 16 which

2 reads as follows:

"Capacity of cans to be used in wholesale trade. When 2 milk or cream is purchased by measure at wholesale by any 3 person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of buy-4 ing or selling milk or cream or both, the can or other vessel 5 containing such milk or cream shall hold eight quarts and 6 one pint and no more, and shall be tried, proved, sealed and 7 marked as herein provided."
