# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend section thirty-six, chapter thirty-six, Revised Statutes, relating to hearings in case of violation of the Apple Packing Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Amend section 36, chapter 36, revised statutes, by striking
2 out the last sentence which reads, "when the hearing relates
3 to the packing of apples, it shall be held in the county where
4 the inspection was made." So that the section as amended
5 will read as follows:

'Sect. 36. Hearing in case of violation. When the com-2 missioner of agriculture becomes cognizant of the violation

3 of any provision of this chapter, he shall cause notice of 4 such fact, stating the date, hour and place of hearing, with 5 a copy of the findings, or, in case of a packer of food, a copy 6 of the charge to be preferred, to be given to the person con-7 cerned and the person from whom the sample was obtained, 8 and the person whose name appears upon the label, (if a resi-9 dent of the state), who shall be given an opportunity to be 10 heard under such rules and regulations as may be pre-11 scribed by the commissioner.'
