#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend section four, chapter forty-eight, Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Amend section 4, chapter 48, revised statutes, by adding 2 to said section the words: 'And may appoint inspectors 3 with authority to perform any part or all of the duties pro-4 vided in sections 5 and 6.' So that said section, as amended, 5 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. State sealer shall enforce provisions of law. 2 He shall enforce the provisions of law requiring municipal 3 officers to procure and maintain standards of weights and 4 measures, and the appointing of a sealer of weights and

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5 measures. He may appoint a deputy who shall have the
6 authority conferred by the two following sections, and may
7 appoint inspectors with authority to perform any part or all
8 of the duties provided in section 5 and 6.'

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
