# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Seventy-nine of Chapter Eightytwo of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Superior Court for the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section seventy-nine of chapter eighty-two of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the fifth line
3 thereof, the words "in Portland" and substituting therefor
4 the words 'in the county of Cumberland.' So that said sec5 tion as amended shall read as follows:

Sect. 79. The superior court established at Portland, 2 within and for the county of Cumberland, shall consist of 3 one justice, an inhabitant of said county, of sobriety of 4 manners and learned in the law, who shall be appointed, 5 commissioned and qualified according to the constitution, 6 and shall reside during his continuance in office, in the coun-7 ty of Cumberland.'
