STATE OF MAINE
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Three, Chapter One Hundred Thirty-four of the Public Laws of the State of Maine of 1895, in Relation to the Judge and Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Portland, Acting as Counsel or Attorney.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 3, chapter 134 of the public laws of 1895 is hereby
2 amended by striking out said section and inserting the fol-
3 lowing:

‘Sect. 3. The judge or recorder shall not act as counsel
2 or attorney in any case, cause, matter or thing which de-
3 pends upon or relates to any cause exclusively cognizable
4 by said court, or which is actually brought in said court,
5 although concurrently cognizable by some other court. But

6 said judge or recorder may so act, however, in matters or
7 causes which while cognizable by said Municipal Court are
8 actually brought in another court having concurrent juris-
9 diction.
