

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Litchfield.

Resolved, That there be appropriated the sum of one hun-

- 2 dred thirty-three dollars and thirty-four cents to be paid to
- 3 the town of Litchfield to reimburse said town for two-thirds
- 4 of two hundred dollars paid by said town to Litchfield
- 5 Academy in the year nineteen hundred seventeen, which
- 6 sum of one hundred thirty-three dollars and thirty-four
- 7 cents is justly due said town from the state under the pro-
- 8 visions of law relating thereto.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Litchfield failed to pay over to Litchfield Academy in nineteen hundred seventeen, \$200 out of a total appropriation of \$600, before the time required by law, and as a result the state refused to pay the two-thirds of the \$200. The town has now paid the \$200, and feels that it should be reimbursed for the two-thirds, viz., \$133.34.
