STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and eighty-seven of
the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, relating
to Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 287 of the public laws of 1917 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the whole of said chapter and inserting
3 in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 42. Whenever any person has once registered a
2 motor vehicle of which he is the owner under the provisions
3 of this chapter, the secretary of state shall, at the request of
4 the person owning a motor vehicle so registered, allow such
5 person to keep and use the same number plates for the entire

6 calendar year for which the plates were issued provided such
7 person complies with the other provisions of the motor
8 vehicle law. The secretary of state shall reserve until
9 December first of each year the same registration number
10 for the succeeding year for persons having registration num-
11 ber two to three thousand for pleasure vehicles and number
12 one to five hundred for commercial vehicles if such person
13 shall previous to the first day of December of the current
14 year pay for the registration of his motor vehicle for the
15 succeeding year and otherwise complies with the provisions
16 of the motor vehicle law.
