STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend an Act to Incorporate the City of Saco.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The common council created by the act to
2 incorporate the city of Saco is hereby abolished, and the
3 city council shall hereafter be composed of the mayor and
4 seven aldermen, one to be chosen from each ward, who are
5 hereby authorized and empowered to do all the things which
6 the city council of Saco have been heretofore authorized to
7 do in the city of Saco.

Sect. 2. The mayor of said Saco shall have an annual
2 salary of one thousand dollars, and the aldermen of said
3 city shall be paid three dollars for every meeting of the

4 city council which they attend, excepting those meetings
5 at which a fee is now paid.

* Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
