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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT Granting Compensation to the Members of the  
Maine Library Commission.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section fifty-two of chapter one hundred and 2  
seventeen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by 3  
inserting after the words "board of accountancy" in the 4  
third line the words 'library commission,' so that said sec- 5  
tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 52. The members of the board of dental examiners, 2  
commissioners of pharmacy, veterinary examiners, board 3  
of accountancy, library commission, and the examiners of 4  
applicants for admission to the bar shall each receive as

5 compensation for their services five dollars a day, for the  
6 time actually spent, and their necessary expenses incurred  
7 in the discharge of their duties, to be certified by the sec-  
8 retaries of their respective boards.'

Sect. 2. So much of section ten of chapter three of the  
2 revised statutes as is inconsistent herewith is hereby re-  
3 pealed.
