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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to amend section twenty-six of chapter seventy of the  
Revised Statutes relating to the Time of Payment of Legacies.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section 26 of chapter 70 of the revised statutes be and  
2 hereby is amended by striking out the words "one year" in  
3 the second and fifth lines of said section and inserting in  
4 place thereof the words 'twenty months.' So that said  
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 26. LEGACIES, WHEN PAYABLE. 1915, c. 244.  
2 Legacies shall be payable in twenty months after final allow-  
3 ance of the will; but such payments shall not be affected by  
4 any claims presented to the executor, or administrator with

5 the will annexed, or filed in the probate office, after the ex-  
6 piration of said twenty months and after such payment; nor  
7 shall the executor or administrator with the will annexed be  
8 responsible for the payments of said legacies on account of  
9 such claims, unless he has failed to give notice of his appoint-  
10 ment as required by law and the judge of probate.'
