AN ACT to Amend Section 19, Chapter 36, Revised Statutes,
Relating to Analysis of Commodities Examined Under the
Inspection Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Amend section 19, chapter 36, revised statutes, by inserting after the word "commodities" in the second line the words 'except milk and cream,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'The commissioner of agriculture shall have all analyses of commodities, except milk and cream, examined under the inspection laws of which he is the executive made at the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station. The director

5 of said station shall analyze or cause to be analyzed all
6 samples submitted to him by said commissioner. Said
7 station shall be compensated to cover the expense of said
8 analyses by said commissioner.'
