STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred Forty-six of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Sixty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen Relating to the Appropriation for the Support of Normal and Training Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred forty-six of chapter sixteen of the 2 revised statutes as amended by chapter sixty-four of the 3 public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby fur-4 ther amended by striking out the words "one hundred ten" 5 in the third line thereof and substituting therefor the words

6 'one hundred twenty-seven' so that said section when 7 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 146. For the support of the five normal schools 2 and the Madawaska Training School, the sum of one hun-3 dred twenty-seven thousand dollars is annually appropri-4 ated, to be expended under the direction of said trustees, 5 which sum the treasurer of state shall deduct for said pur-6 pose from any school money raised for the support of 7 common schools. The governor and council may from 8 time to time, as they think proper, draw warrants therefor 9 on said treasurer in favor of said trustees.'
