# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE in Favor of John P. Haney of Bangor, Penobscot County, State of Maine.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the appro-2 priation for teachers' pensions to John P. Haney of Bangor, 3 Penobscot county, state of Maine, the sum of one hundred 4 twenty-five dollars per year, in addition to the sum reg-5 ularly received by said John P. Haney from said appro-6 priation. Said sum to be paid in quarterly installments 7 during the lifetime of said John P. Haney.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

John P. Haney is a man eighty-four years of age and was a school teacher in the public schools of this state for a period of forty-three years, but under the present law he draws a half pension of one hundred and twenty-five dollars per year and the purpose of this resolve is to enable him to receive the sum of two hundred fifty dollars per year.
