AN ACT to Prohibit the Use of Cod Nets or Trawls Between the First Day of February and the First Day of June of Each Year Within Certain Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The use of cod nets or trawls between the first day of

2 February and the first day of June of each year is hereby

3 prohibited within the following waters:

A direct line drawn from Jasper's Head to Spindle on

- 2 Thornton's Point, Machias Bay, from Point of Main to
- 3 Black Head, Englishman's Bay, from Seaduck Point on
- 4 Beal's Island to Wallace Point, Moose Peck, from North
- 5 End Dubert Island to Wash Point, Cape Split in Narragua-
- 6 gus Bay, from Petit Manan Point to Cranberry Point,

17 Light.

- 7 Dyer's Bay, and Gouldsboro Bay, from North End of 8 Herring Island to Schooner Head, Frenchman's Bay, from 9 Dodge's Point to Naskeag Point, Bluehill Bay, from South 10 Point of Orr's Cove to Sabbathday Harbor Point, from 11 North End of Seven Hundred Acre Island to Frohock's 12 Wharf, Penobscot Bay, from South Point of Hooper's 13 Island to South Side of New Harbor, Muscongus Bay, 14 from Pemaquid Point to Ram Island Light, John's Bay, 15 from Cape Newagen to Griffin's Head, Sheepscott River,
 - Whoever violates any provision of this Act shall be pun-2 ished by fine not less than one hundred dollars nor more 3 than two hundred dollars for each offense.
