STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws and of the Commissioners from Maine for the Promotion of Uniformity of Legislation in the United States.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) 2 for year 1919, and the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) 3 for the year 1920, be, and hereby is, appropriated, two 4 hundred dollars (\$200) each year to be paid to the national 5 conference of commissioners on uniform state laws, and so 6 much of the balance of three hundred dollars (\$300) each 7 year as may be necessary to be paid to the commissioners of 8 Maine for the promotion of uniformity of legislation in the 9 United States for their expenses in attending the national

10 conference of commissioners on uniform state laws, for
11 drafting and printing reports, postage, and for their other
12 expenses in performing the duties of said office.
