AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and ninety-five of the
Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen Creating the
Board of Prison Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 195 of the public laws of 1917 is hereby amended
2 by adding to said chapter the following section:

‘Sect. 11. The commission may appoint a state probation
2 officer to serve during its pleasure and who shall perform
3 such duties in connection with the employment, care and
4 supervision of paroled convicts as the commission may de-
5 termine. The compensation of said probation officer shall
6 be established by the commission, subject to the approval of
7 the governor and council, and he shall receive his necessary
8 expenses incurred in the performance of his duty.’
