RESOLVE, in Favor of Several Academies, Institutes, Seminaries and Colleges for Maintenance and for Repairs and Improvements.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in  
2 favor of the academies, institutes, seminaries and colleges  
3 hereinafter listed the sum of thirty-two thousand eighty-  
4 five dollars for the year nineteen hundred nineteen, and  
5 the sum of twenty-nine thousand seven hundred eighty-  
6 five dollars for the year nineteen hundred twenty, said  
7 sums to be expended under the direction of the board of  
8 trustees of said institutions to the amount and for the  
9 purposes indicated in the following schedule.
