STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse C. H. Robinson Company of Port-
land, Maine, for goods sold and delivered to the State, and
for which purchaser failed to file with the State Auditor a
Copy of the Order.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of one hundred seventy-seven dollars and forty-two
3 cents to be paid to C. H. Robinson Company, a corporation
4 duly organized and having its place of business in Portland,
5 Maine, for goods and merchandise delivered to the state of
6 Maine between March eleventh, nineteen hundred sixteen
7 and January twenty-third, nineteen hundred seventeen, but
8 for which the order was not duly filed in the office of the
9 state auditor.
