RESOLVE, in favor of Charles E. Darling, Superintendent of the State Fish Hatchery, Enfield, Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of fifty dollars and forty-three

- 2 cents (\$50.43) be and hereby is appropriated to be paid
- 3 Charles E. Darling, superintendent of the State Fish Hatch-
- 4 ery, Enfield, Maine, to reimburse him for installing a light-
- 5 ing system in said hatchery.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is presented for the purpose of reimbursing Mr. Darling for the amount expended by him in installing a lighting system in the State Fish Hatchery at Enfield. Mr. Darling also installed a water system costing \$91.44 for which he has been reimbursed by order of the governor and council, but as no funds were available from which this claim for installing the lighting system could be paid, this resolve is introduced for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of this bill.
