STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of the Augusta State Hospital, for the construction of a new building for patients.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for 2 the Augusta State Hospital, the sum of \$75,000 for the year 3 nineteen hundred and nineteen and the sum of \$50,000 for 4 the year nineteen hundred and twenty, for the construction 5 and equipment of a building to accommodate one hundred 6 patients, to be expended under the direction of the board 7 of state hospital trustees, with the approval of the governor 8 and council. Provided, that any balance of the sums above 9 appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen 10 which may remain unexpended at the end of the year shall

11 be available for expenditure during the year nineteen 12 hundred and twenty, and provided further, that the governor 13 and council may, by order, upon recommendation of the 14 trustees of the said institutions, authorize the use of unex-15 pended balances of any of the above appropriations to meet 16 deficiencies in other appropriations for the same institution.
