RESOLVE, in favor of the Bangor State Hospital for Maintenance and other Purposes for the years Nineteen Hundred Nineteen and Nineteen Hundred Twenty.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the Bangor State Hospital,

Total for maintenance....\$236,000 00 \$236,000 00 Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropriated 2 for the year nineteen hundred nineteen which may remain 3 unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for 4 expenditure during the year nineteen hundred twenty; and 5 provided further, that the governor and council may, by 6 order, upon recommendation of the trustees of the said in-7 stitutions, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any 8 of the above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other 9 appropriations for the same institution.
