STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Authorizing the Clark Power Company to Construct and Maintain a Dam or Dams on Saco Waters in the Cities of Saco and Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Clark Power Company, incorporated under the pro2 visions of chapter two hundred and fifty of the private and
3 special laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, its successors
4 and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to con5 struct and maintain a dam or dams across the Saco river
6 and across branches, canals and waterways leading there7 from, at any point between or within the cities of Saco
8 and Biddeford, in the county of York, upon lands now
9 owned or hereafter acquired by said company, its suc-

10 cessors and assigns, for the purpose of developing power 11 for any and all purposes, and said company and its suc12 cessors and assigns is also authorized and empowered to
13 transmit, furnish and sell electricity, generated by the water
14 power of said river at said dam or dams, or otherwise, for
15 power and light to the Pepperell Manufacturing Company,
16 its successors and assigns, the York Manufacturing Com17 pany, its successors and assigns, the Cumberland County
18 Power and Light Company, its successors and assigns, and
19 the York County Power Company, its successors and as20 signs.
