RESOLVE, in Favor of the State Tuberculosis Sanatoriums  
for Maintenance and Other Purposes for the Years Nineteen  
Hundred and Nineteen and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty.

---

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated  
FOR THE CENTRAL MAINE SANATORIUM

For Personal Services, namely, for salaries and wages of  
2 all officers and employees except those wholly engaged in  
3 repairs of buildings and equipment, for the year nineteen  
4 hundred and nineteen, the sum of nineteen thousand and  
5 fifty dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred and twenty  
6 the sum of nineteen thousand and fifty dollars.

For Food Supplies, namely, all articles of food, for the  
2 year nineteen hundred and nineteen the sum of forty thou-  
3 sand eight hundred dollars, and for the year nineteen hun-  
4 dred and twenty the sum of forty thousand eight hundred  
5 dollars.

For Clothing, namely, all articles of personal clothing  
2 and materials for making the same, for the year nineteen  
3 hundred and nineteen, the sum of one hundred twenty-five  
4 dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, the  
5 sum of one hundred twenty-five dollars.

For Repairs and Equipment, namely, all materials and  
2 supplies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and  
3 attached fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replace-  
4 ments of furniture and equipment, including farm equip-  
5 ment and livestock, and all personal services rendered  
6 wholly in connection with repair work, for the year nine-  
7 teen hundred and nineteen, the sum of six thousand seven  
8 hundred dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred and  
9 twenty, the sum of six thousand seven hundred dollars.

For General Expenses, namely, all other materials, sup-  
2 plies and expenses incident to maintenance of the institu-  
3 tion and the patients thereof, whether present or absent,  
4 for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of  
5 twenty-five thousand nine hundred and seventy-five dollars,  
6 and for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, the sum of  
7 twenty-five thousand nine hundred seventy-five dollars.

For Additions and Improvements for the year nineteen

2 hundred and nineteen, the sum of twenty-three thousand  
3 five hundred dollars.

FOR THE NORTHERN MAINE SANATORIUM

For Building and Equipment, for the year nineteen hun-  
2 dred and nineteen, the sum of thirty thousand dollars.

For Maintenance, including personal services, food sup-  
2 plies, clothing, repairs and equipment and general expenses,  
3 for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of  
4 five thousand dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred  
5 and twenty, the sum of thirty thousand dollars.

FOR THE WESTERN MAINE SANATORIUM

For Personal Services, namely, for salaries and wages of  
2 all officers and employees except those wholly engaged in  
3 repairs of buildings and equipment, for the year nineteen  
4 hundred and nineteen, the sum of twenty-four thousand  
5 six hundred fifty dollars, and for the year nineteen hun-  
6 dred and twenty, the sum of twenty-four thousand six  
7 hundred fifty dollars.

For Food Supplies, namely, all articles of food, for the  
2 year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of twenty-  
3 five thousand dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred  
4 and twenty, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars.

For Repairs and Equipment, namely, all materials and  
2 supplies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and  
3 attached fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replace-  
4 ments of furniture and equipment, including farm equip-  
5 ment and livestock, and all personal services rendered

6 wholly in connection with repair work, for the year nine-  
7 teen hundred and nineteen, the sum of twenty thousand  
8 dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred and twenty, the  
9 sum of twenty thousand dollars.

For General Expenses, namely, all other materials, sup-  
2 plies and expenses incident to maintenance of the institu-  
3 tion and the patients thereof, whether present or absent,  
4 for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of  
5 twenty-three thousand dollars, and for the year nineteen  
6 hundred and twenty, the sum of twenty-three thousand  
7 dollars.

For Additions and Improvements, for the year nineteen  
2 hundred and nineteen, the sum of six thousand dollars.

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appro-  
2 priated for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen which  
3 may remain unexpended at the end of the year shall be  
4 available for expenditure during the year nineteen hundred  
5 and twenty, and provided further, that the expenditures of  
6 all of the sums above appropriated by, or under the con-  
7 trol of, the trustees of said sanatoriums, shall be subject  
8 to the direction and approval of the governor and council,  
9 who may, by order, upon recommendation of the said trus-  
10 tees, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of  
11 the above appropriations to meet the deficiencies for the  
12 same institution.
