STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Public Roads of Oxford County, in Accordance with an Act of Congress, Approved May 23rd, 1908.

Resolved: That the money received from the Depart-2 ment of Agriculture of the United States, under the resolve 3 of Congress approved May 23d, 1908, amounting to \$287.07, 4 is hereby transferred to the county treasurer of Oxford 5 county.

Resolved: That the county commissioners of Oxford 2 county are hereby authorized to expend said sum of \$287.07 3 on the public roads of the county of Oxford, in such man-4 ner as they shall judge to be for the best interests of said 5 county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The money herein transferred to the county treasurer of Oxford county was received under an Act of Congress approved May 23, 1908, which provides as follows:

"That hereafter twenty-five per centum of all money received from each forest reserve during any fiscal year, including the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and eight, shall be paid at the end thereof by the secretary of the treasury to the state or territory in which said reserve is situated, to be expended as the state or territorial legislature may prescribe for the benefit of the public schools and public roads of the county or counties in which the forest reserve is situated: Provided, that when any forest reserve is in more than one state or territory or county the distributive share of each from the proceeds of said reserve shall be proportional to its area therein."

The forest reserve from which this money is derived is situated in Oxford county.
